What Kind of Items Can You Dispose of?



You may only dispose of items that you have used at home or by yourself.

*Please have rechargeable batteries to be disposed of as business-related waste disposed of properly by the business operator as "industrial waste."

Small rechargeable batteries



Lithium-ion batteries



Nickel-metal hydride batteries



Nickel-cadmium batteries

Products with built-in small rechargeable batteries

*No larger than 30 cm



Mobile batteries



Heated cigarettes
Electronic cigarettes



Electric shavers



Handy fans, etc.

In Arakawa City, items without a recycling mark may also be put out for collection. However, please note that they cannot be put out for collection at JBRC collection partner establishments.

How to Dispose of Other Batteries



The method of disposal varies depending on the type of battery.



Dispose of as non-burnable garbage collected twice a month

Dry cell batteries



Dispose of coin cell batteries (model numbers BR and CR) as non-burnable garbage

Coin cell batteries and button cell batteries

Other batteries should be brought to a collection partner establishment



Contact the distributor where you purchased the battery

Lead-acid batteries

* Accepted on **weekdays from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM (No. 1 and No. 2 are also available on Saturdays)**

* Accepted at Yui no Mori Arakawa (No. 4) only on days the facility is open (Not accepted on days the facility is closed)

* Please **make sure** to put small rechargeable batteries, etc. in the "small rechargeable battery recycle bin."

* At Yui no Mori Arakawa (No. 4), please **hand over batteries to the staff at the General Counter on the 1st Floor.**

* **Please make sure to bring swollen batteries to the 2nd floor of the Cleaning and Recycling Office.**

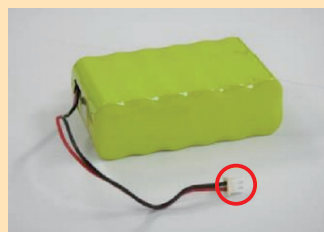


How Do You Dispose of These Items?
